LVI performed asbestos abatement and total demolition of 2,700 military housing units on seven Naval Air Stations; Charleston, Jacksonville, Pensacola, Mayport, Key West, Meridian, Whiting Field; and on the Naval Submarine Base at King's Bay.

Asbestos abatement included removal and disposal of various asbestos containing materials that were used in the construction of single-story duplexes and two-story "eightplexes" for military housing at these locations.

Following asbestos abatement, LVI demolished, removed and disposed of all construction debris. LVI was also involved in on-site concrete crushing, disposal and/or recycling and demolition of some underground utilities.
