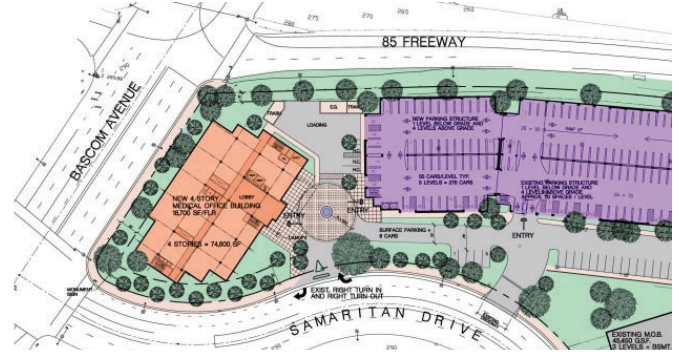

The Samaritan Medical Center Campus is comprised of more than 300,000 square feet of medical facilities housing 200 physicians and is located near the intersection of Highways 17 and 85 on the San Jose-Los Gatos border.
