LVI was selected by Whiting Turner to apply spray-on fire-proofing to the new 120,000 SF, 5-story Li Ka Shing Center for Learning and Knowledge at Stanford University.

The building was designed as teaching, research and conference facilities and features space ranging from lecture halls and small-group discussion areas to a flexible use conference space accommodating up to 360 people. The center also provides a 21st century biomedical library with 90 percent of its content in digital format and a new Center for Immersive and Simulation-Based Learning.

The building was constructed in multiple phases and was built between two existing buildings, which restricted site access. LVI accomplished working under these special conditions and challenges to complete the project on schedule and within budget.
