


VA CONNECTICUT HEALTHCARE SYSTEM | WEST HAVEN & NEWINGTON, CT







Since 2009, LVI has performed numberous asbestos abatement and selective demolition projects at Connecticut's two operational Veterans Affairs Medical Centers.

- » Asbestos abatement and mold remediation of occupied buildings on the West Haven campus; 18-month, \$2,000,000 project completed on-time, on-budget.
- » Interior demolition and abatement of chilled water lines in 200 separate, highlysensitive areas; 6-month, \$629,000 project completed on-time, on-budget.
- Interior demolition and asbestos abatement of 15,000 SF chemotherapy center;
 2-month, \$255,000 project completed on-time, on-budget.
- » Emergency mold remediation, asbestos abatement, and lead abatement throughout both West Haven and Newington campuses; Initial reponse in 24 hours or less included proper containment and negative air following the Department of Veterans Affairs Infection Control Risk Assessment (ICRA) protocols.
- » Emergency mold remediation of Sterile Processing Department (SPD) amidst design-build restoration; project completed on-time, on-budget.
- » Ongoing selective demolition of operational pharmacies during upgrades by SEK-TECH to meet USP 797 standards, which are the current guidelines, procedures and compliance requirements for compounding sterile preparations.
